### Minutes of Area Meeting Held 14/10/11, Clock & Key Inn, Trispen, Truro.

The meeting was opened at 7.10pm. by the chairman who welcomed everyone present. Apologies for absence were received from Peter Austin, Truro MFC.. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as correct, and there were no matters arising from that meeting. Commenting on the years events the chairman felt they had been well received and were a sound base for next year. The secretary had received an invitation for all our clubs to view the Childrens Hospice following our donation earlier, and the contact details were distributed. Truro's Scale day had proceeded as planned and was lucky with a dry, if breezy, day. The Treasurer confirmed the account currently held £1556, and payments to clubs for their various events would follow. Delegate Pete Disney discussed the Leicester Council meeting he had attended recently and notified us of the forthcoming change in insurance provider that had been arranged. Members were also advised of a proposed increase in membership fees for next year. Clubs were then asked to consider the competition scoring system and after a wide-ranging discussion it was decided not to award a major trophy this year; the concensus view was for individual event prizes next year, leading towards an overall club award. The chairman was to consider details and would present a proposal next year. A general review of the years events followed; one of the main requirements would be the early and clear notification to clubs of the classes, schedules and eligibility expected from entrants. St. Austell suggested the inclusion of a Vintage event would be popular and offered to put forward details in due course. Truro suggested that we could offer to endorse an event for helicopters if there were sufficient interest, to which members agreed, and enquiries between the relevent clubs would follow. Davidstow felt it neccessary to ensure our adverts for events stressed that they would be open to all members, regardless of acheivement levels, and it was accepted that this may not have been clear this year. Redruth reported that the proceeds from their fun-fly event had been included in a donation of £300 they had made to their charity, FLEET. During other business the date of our A.G.M. was set and members were advised of the posts that were due for election. There was further discussion on the subject of the "C" certificate standards, and both St. Austell and Redruth would meet to discuss a joint schedule that could be tried here next year. There being no further business the meeting closed at 8.45pm..
